Sub: TNTEU – Streamlining the admission of students in B.Ed Programme in Self-Financing Colleges of Education – Admission Procedures - Issued for the academic year 2018-19 – reg.

I am, by direction, to inform that in order to ensure quality teacher preparation by streamlining the admission of students in B.Ed Self-financing colleges of education, the following Admission Guidelines are issued to the Self-financing Colleges of Education affiliated to this University for the academic year 2018-2019 onwards.

- 1. The Self-financing colleges of education can start their admission from the date of advertisement to be released by the Directorate of Collegiate Education, Chennai, calling for applications for admission to B.Ed programme in Government/Government Aided colleges of education in Tamil Nadu (The exact date for starting B.Ed admission will be notified on the University website on the day of the advertisement.).
- 2. As informed earlier in our circular dated 12.02.2018, the last date for closing the admission to B.Ed programme is the 15th day from the date of Single-Window Counselling to be conducted by the Government (The exact date for closing B.Ed admission will be notified on the University website.).
- 3. Each college of education should constitute an <u>Admission Committee</u> consisting of the <u>Principal</u> and other <u>two Senior Faculty Members</u> of the college.

- 4. The functions of the Admission Committee are:
 - i) Calling for applications for the B.Ed programme (from the date announced by the University)
 - ii) Preparing a merit list based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination for admission of students
 - iii) Admitting students strictly based on the Admission Guidelines which will be issued by the Directorate of Collegiate Education, Chennai for the academic year 2018-2019 with special reference to reservation policy and minimum eligibility mark for admission.
 - iv) To facilitate participatory teaching and learning in pedagogical courses and practical activities, there should not be more than 25 students per teacher for a pedagogical subject / school subject (for a maximum of 2 units of 100 students' intake)
 - v) Obtaining an undertaking from students as well as parents / guardians in the Format prescribed by Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University for ensuring regular attendance in colleges of education.
 - vi) After thorough verification by the Admission Committee, the list of students admitted in the colleges of education should be uploaded the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University website www.tnteu.in
 - vii) After uploading the Admission List on the University website, the same should be put up on the College Notice board with the signatures of the members of Admission Committee of the respective College.
- 5. The Admission List should be submitted to the University for approval with the signature of the Principal whose appointment is approved by the University. The Admission List without the signature of the approved Principal will not be considered.
- 6. The Scrutiny Committee duly appointed by the University will check and verify the list of applications of students admitted by the colleges of education and the University will approve and issue eligibility order for the B.Ed admission for each college of education within a week zonal-wise.

The Principals/Secretaries of all the Self-financing Colleges of Education are requested to strictly follow the above admission procedures for admission of B.Ed students in their colleges for the academic year 2018-2019.
