I am to invite attention to the references cited.

2) I am to state that in the State, the process of Innovation is institutionalized and necessary financial and administrative support has been provided to implement the innovation. Accordingly, the Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) has been established in the erstwhile State Planning Commission "to promote innovation culture in Tamil Nadu" and a "State Innovation Fund" has been created.

3) As per the guidelines issued in the G.O. second referred above there will be two round of sanction for funding from the State Innovation Fund. Therefore, the detailed proposals which are new / novel / unconventional / creative intervention / approach / organization model / operative process / service to tackle the identified issue / problem that would lead to a substantial improvement in developmental / governance outcomes are requested from the departments for the second round of appraisal for 2020-21 by the State Development Policy Council on or before **30.06.2020**.

4) I am to state that the Innovative proposals, to be eligible for funding under the State Innovation Fund will require to fulfill the criteria prescribed in the Para 2 x of the G.O. second cited. The proposals weeded out previously by the erstwhile State Planning Commission as well as similar proposals should not be forwarded again. However, the proposals that were considered by erstwhile State Planning Commission and suggested for revision may be included with suitable modifications in accordance with the suggestions were made. The detailed proposal should be forwarded along with the appraisal format which is enclosed with this letter. The detailed proposal without appraisal format (or) the appraisal format without detailed proposal will be summarily rejected. It is also insisted that the proposals should clearly articulate the specific innovation to be implemented / tested duly identifying a public issue or problem and the proposals which do not constitute an innovation will not be considered.
