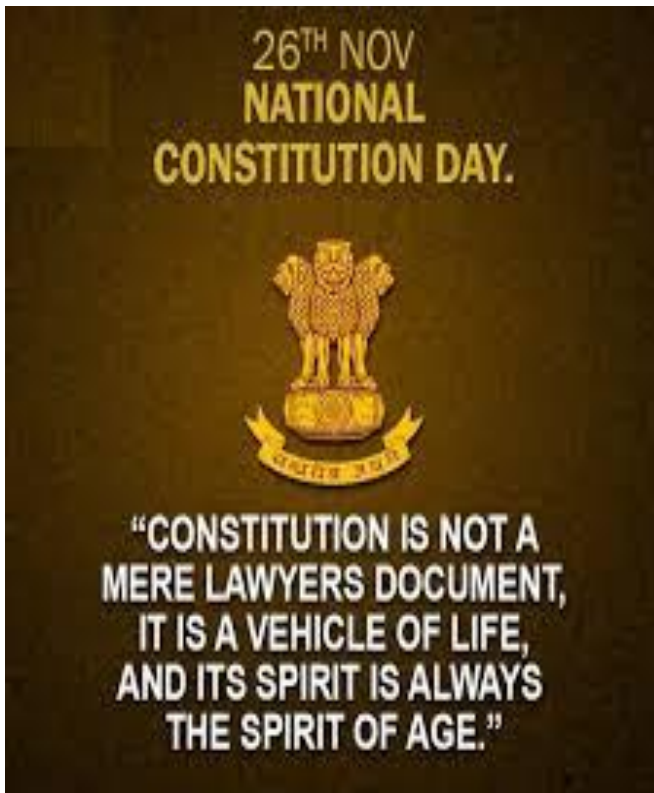

DEPARTMENT OF CURRICULUM PLANNING AND EVALUATION

A Mega three-day international conference on "Trends in curriculum development and the Role of Teachers as Envisaged by Pioneers in Education" was organized by the Department of Curriculum Planning and Evaluation of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University Karapakkam Chennai in association with ESN publication, held from November 26th to 28th, 2021, at Hotel Turyaa Chennai.

The total number of themes and research papers received was over 150 on various aspects of the curriculum and the role of teachers. The international mega-conference began with a welcome speech by Conference Director Dr. Balakrishnan. He greeted all the dignitaries with cute Tamil poetic quotes and gave welcome address. Dr. K. Devisri, Organizing Secretary, delivered the concept note of the conference. Next, Dr. R. Senthil Kumar, Assistant Professor Department of Curriculum Planning and Evaluation signified the note of the conference monograph.

S. No	LEARNING DISABILITY	SYMPTOMS
1	DYSCALCULIA	A specific learning disability that affects a person's ability to understand numbers and learn math facts.
2	DYSGRAPHIA	A specific learning disability that affects a person's handwriting ability and fine motor skills.
3	DYSLEXIA	A specific learning disability that affects reading and related language-based processing skills
4	NON-VERBAL LEARNING DISABILITIES	Has trouble interpreting nonverbal cues like facial expressions or body language and may have poor coordination
5	ORAL / WRITTEN LANGUAGE DISORDER AND SPECIFIC READING COMPREHENSION DEFICIT	Learning disabilities that affect an individual's understanding of what they read or of spoken language. The ability to express one's self with oral language may also be impacted. Dyspraxia
6	DYSPRAXIA	A disorder which causes problems with movement and coordination, language and speech.
