- **Verify the name of the candidate** with reference to the name as found in the basic records i.e., SSLC Book or Plus Two mark statement. In case of any change, make sure that such change is supported by Publication in the Government Gazette.
- **Verify the date of birth** with reference to basic document i.e, SSLC Book or Plus two mark statement and also **sex and community of the candidate**. In case of any change in the date of birth, the birth certificate be called for and verified.
- **No new candidates shall be included in this edit nominal roll list.**
- **Verify the candidates' core and optional subjects** and correct subject if there is any change.
- Mention the **discontinued students** in the edit nominal roll if any for the current academic year 2020-2024.
- If any corrections are required, make them legibly with **Red Ink** only.
- Note that any subsequent **corrections** in future shall not be entertained under any circumstances. Hence, incorporate all required corrections now itself. Kindly take note that the data base now created shall be used for the conduct of B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed. Degree Examinations and no separate examination application forms shall be issued for the examinations to be held in April 2021.
- The examination fee mentioned in the edit nominal roll list should be paid by the college through online mode by using the below link which will be available in the university website as "**B.Sc.B.Ed. / B.A.B.Ed. Exam Fees (2020-2021) Payment Link**".
- The colleges should not pay the exam fees for discontinued students if any for the current academic year 2020-2024.

- The Examination fee, as a must, shall be collected from all the candidates for all the papers whose admissions for B.Sc.B.Ed./B.A.B.Ed. Courses have been provisionally approved for the academic year 2020-2024 irrespective of the fact whether they are appearing for the examinations in April 2021 or not.
