event of taking of Mass Anti-Drug Pledge on 11th August 2026 under the leadership of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu.

2. During the meeting, the following decisions were made :

In the proposed event of August 11, 2026, the Students from Arts and Science Colleges, Engineering Colleges, Polytechnic and ITI Students, Medical, Nursing, NCC/NSS Students and School students will participate and take pledge against drug abuse. Simultaneously, the district should organized pledge events in their respective districts.

(Action: Higher Education/ School Education/ Health and Family Welfare Departments)

Large number of Students from schools and colleges including Deemed Universities and Private Schools will be linked through video conferencing and take e-pledge during the event and the same is available in <https://www.drugfreetamilnadu.tn.gov.in/en#pledge>. Certificates can be downloaded from this web portal.

All District Level Officers of various departments such as Revenue, Health and Family Welfare, School Education, Higher Education and Police etc. shall participate in Programs at different places in the districts preferably in educational institutions.

3. For successful conduct of this programme, coordination with various departments is required and the following have been decided.

Higher Education, School Education, Youth welfare and Sports and Health and Family welfare Departments

- To assemble 1,500 students at the venue in coordination with the Greater Chennai Police as detailed below:
 1. Director of Collegiate Education – 600
 2. Director of Technical Education – 300
 3. Youth Welfare and Sports -300
 4. Medical/Paramedical – 100
 5. Schools – 200

All concerned departments to fix a nodal officer to mobilize students and share it with Event nodal officer Thiru.N.Mathivanan, SP, NIBCID unit. Based on the seating capacity of the venue, the number of participants may be increased/decreased.

- All educational institutions shall conduct the programme at their respective institutional level. Institutions located near the district headquarters shall participate in the main programme led by the District Collector.

- To prepare a schedule for the one week awareness programme and circulate the same to the concerned authorities.
- To Circulate the "Pledge copy" to all educational Institutions all over the State.
- To issue awards to best coordinators of Anti Drug Clubs and Volunteering teams at district level.
- To instruct all District Level Educational Officers (DEOs/CEOs) and RJDs to ensure that an awareness program is organized in all Government & Private Educational Institutions including Schools, Colleges, and Professional institutions, before or after taking the pledge, including screening of videos, organizing skits, lectures by resources persons, speech by students on drug awareness etc.
- To instruct all District Level officers to send a compliance report in a prescribed format furnishing details of programs organized within their jurisdiction with number of students attended and to make arrangements for safe and timely arrival and departure of students in co-ordination with Greater Chennai Police.
