This partnership will expand your institution's visibility across India and help build a strong network with both current and former students. By showcasing your institution's activities on the portal, you can engage more youth and attract them for enrollment and other opportunities.

One of its immediate opportunities on the portal is regarding the **Viksit Bharat Young Leaders Dialogue**, i.e., the reimagined National Youth Festival, 2025. A significant highlight of the festival is the **Viksit Bharat Challenge**, comprising a quiz, an essay writing segment and development of a vision deck. Youth selected through this multi-tiered challenge will get an unprecedented opportunity to present their vision of Viksit Bharat directly to the Hon'ble Prime Minister during the two day national level dialogue to be held in New Delhi on 11th and 12th Jan 2025. The first step of this challenge, i.e. the Viksit Bharat Quiz will be accessible for all youth (aged 15-29 years) on the MY Bharat portal , from **25th November to 5th December, 2024**.

Concept Note For Viksit Bharat Young Leaders Dialogue' 2025

A) Objectives of the Reimagination:

1. To enhance youth participation in politics and civic life, responding to the Hon'ble Prime Minister's call during his Independence Day address to engage 1 lakh youth in these spheres. The National Youth Festival is designed to identify and nurture young talent with leadership potential, providing them a platform to share their ideas for a Viksit Bharat directly before the Hon'ble Prime Minister
2. To ensure the meaningful contribution of youth towards a Viksit Bharat through a transparent and democratic, merit-based selection system. This initiative underscores our commitment to empowering the next generation to drive India's progress and development.

B) Key Highlights

1. The Viksit Bharat Challenge:

A Transparent and Merit based system to identify young leaders.

- **Step 1 (Digital) (25th November- 5th December) – Viksit Bharat Quiz (Prelims):** Individual participants will take part in an online quiz on general knowledge and India's achievements. This will be a general quiz. The rank list will be announced on **6th November.** **Incentive: Online Participation Certificate.**
- **Step 2 (Digital) – Viksit Bharat Essay (8th December- 15th December):** Selected participants will submit a 1,000-word essay on the abovementioned themes. Result will be declared on **18th December.** **Incentive: Letter of Appreciation from relevant authority.**

- Empowering Youth for Viksit Bharat
- Making India the Vishwaguru
- Making India the Startup Capital of the World
- FIT India- A means to Viksit Bharat

- Empowering Women and Improving Social Indicators

- **Step 3 (In-Person) – Viksit Bharat PPT Challenge (20th December- 26rd December):** 100 selected candidates from each track will be invited for the State rounds. Each State will select top 4 participants from each track to form the team for that track of the State. Each State will proportionately send teams in each theme for the National Championship. 10-20 teams sent per state depending on the size. **Incentive: Letter of Appreciation from MP/CM.**
- **Step 4 (In-Person) – Viksit Bharat Championship at NYF: On 11th January** we will hold elimination rounds to select the top teams to present for the Finals. These top teams will present before the PM on 12th January. **Incentive: Letter of Appreciation from the PM**

2. Plenary Session & Panel Discussion

Plenary Sessions during the inaugural, mid-session, and closing ceremony, bringing together influential national and global leaders, along with the grand plenary session of Hon'ble Prime Minister.

3. Viksit Bharat Exhibition- Vision @2047

The Viksit Bharat Exhibition at the National Youth Festival will showcase youth-focused initiatives from states and central ministries, offering interactive experiences for youth to explore opportunities and engage with stakeholders shaping India's Viksit Bharat vision.

State Exhibition	Ministry Exhibition
The States' Exhibition will feature stalls from all states, each showcasing new initiatives and programs aimed at empowering youth across various fields, including education, skill development, entrepreneurship, and culture.	Additionally, the Ministry Exhibition will have separate stalls from various government ministries, each highlighting key schemes and projects that support youth, including leadership development, innovation, and participation in governance.

- 4. Viksit Bharat- A cultural Extravaganza :** A grand cultural exhibit that will showcase the theme 'Vikas Bhi Virasat Bhi' through light and sound show, cultural performances and dance performances.

SOP for On boarding Knowledge Institutions (having NSS Unit) on MYBharat Portal

A. Checklist –

1. One Computer with Internet Access (mobile can be used for setup but not recommended)
2. Details (Name, Gender, DOB, Mobile Number of Nodal Officer /Nominee(optional)
3. One Banner and One Logo on Institution (to be displayed on public page)
 - Upload Banner – Size 1 MB,
 - Upload logo – Size 1 MB,
4. Signed and Stamped document for Institutional Affiliation and Authorized Person – Placed at Annexure -1
5. UDISE/AISHE ID/ ITI Code (If available)

B. Detailed Steps for Onboarding-

1. Access MYBharat Portal

- Open any web browser and navigate to the MYBharat portal: <https://mybharat.gov.in/>

2. Initiate Partner Registration - On the homepage, click on "Get Started" and then select "Partner – Register".

3. Nodal Officer Credentials

- Enter the registered Email address of the designated Nodal Officer for your institution (PO NSS) on the MYBharat portal.
- Upon entering the credentials, a one-time password (OTP) will be sent for verification. Enter the received OTP to proceed.

*Note - This nodal officer will be able to create organization structure on the MY Bharat portal and will also be able to create Events, ELP Opportunities, and Approve Students. This Nodal Officer can be PO of NSS and they will register their KI with their email id. **It is to be noted that the mobile number which has already been used earlier by the PO NSS during their registration is not to be used again in the portal during onboarding of their respective KIs.***

4. Enter Personal Details -Fill in the required personal details of the Nodal Officer:

- Name
- Date of Birth
- Gender

5. Specify Location - Select the state, district, block/local body, and pin code associated with your institution.

6. Choose Organization Type -From the available options, select "Knowledge Institution" as the organization type.

7. Create Institution Account - Click on the "Create Institution" button to initiate the institution registration process.

8. Select State and District - Choose the state and district where your institution is located.

9. Specify Institution Type

- Select the appropriate institution type from the dropdown menu:
 - College
 - School
 - University
 - ITI
 - Polytechnic

10. Choose Institution Subcategory (if applicable) - This step is only applicable for College, School, and University categories. Select the relevant subcategory:

- **College**
 - Affiliated College
 - Constituent/University College
 - Autonomous College
 - Others
- **School**
 - CBSE
 - CISCE
 - State Board
 - Others
- **University**
 - Recognized by UGC
 - Institutions of National Importance
 - Others

11. Search or Enter Institution Name

- Knowledge institutions can search for their institution using the UDISE code (for Schools) or AISHE code (for Universities/Colleges).
- ***Note If your institution's name doesn't appear in the dropdown list, select "Others" and manually enter the complete name.***

12. Provide Nodal Officer Designation - Enter the official designation of the Nodal Officer within the institution.

13. Specify Funding Source

- Select the funding category that applies to your institution:

- Central Govt
- State Govt
- Private

14. Describe the Institution

- In the "About" text field, provide a detailed description of your knowledge institution. This information will be displayed publicly on the institution's profile page on the MYBharat portal.

15. Choose Institution Specialization - If applicable, select the area of specialization of your institution from the available options.

16. Indicate NSS Unit Presence - Select "YES" if your institution has a functional National Service Scheme (NSS) unit. Otherwise, choose "NO".

17. Upload Institution Media

- Upload the following visual identity elements for your institution:
 - Institution Banner/Photo (recommended size: 1 MB, format: JPG/JPEG/PNG)
 - Institution Logo (recommended size: 1 MB, format: JPG/JPEG/PNG)

18. Submit Signed Document

- Upload a signed and stamped document verifying the institution's details and the authorized Nodal Officer. A template for this document can be found in Annexure-1 and the same can be downloaded from the MYBharat portal too.

19. Provide Contact Information -Enter the official contact details and address of your knowledge institution.

20. Add Nominee (Optional)

- The authorized Nodal Officer has the option to add a nominee for the MYBharat portal access. This step is not mandatory.

Note – The Nominee will be able to create organization structure on the MYBharat portal and will also be able to create Events, ELP Opportunities, and Approve Students..

21. Declare Designation -Knowledge institutions can choose to declare if the details filled correspond to the Vice Chancellor (for universities) or Principal (for schools/colleges).

22. Preview and Submit

- Carefully review the application form to ensure all details are accurate. Once satisfied, click the "Submit" button to finalize the onboarding process for your knowledge institution on the MYBharat portal.
